Annual Requirement of Funds

Bait-ul-Sukoon Trust needs Rs. 455 million during the year 2023, in order to continue providing totally free healthcare facilities to all cancer patients.

No donation is too large or too small.

The projected cost to be incurred in 2023, on Chemotherapy alone will be Rs. 116.4 million, Radiotherapy Rs. 32.1 million, Diagnostics Rs. 25.6 million, and Surgeries Rs. 29.7 million. The costs associated with these and other services are expected to further increase by 65% due to the rising costs and increase in patients by approx. 25%.
