


# Beyond Treatment: Providing Free Wigs to Support Cancer Patients

BSCHH is the first hospital internationally to run the **“Hope and Beauty”** initiative, an ongoing program through which premium wigs from Wig-O-Mania are distributed free of cost every month to female cancer patients experiencing hair loss due to chemotherapy.

This initiative is designed to do more than address physical changes, it aims to restore confidence, dignity, and emotional well-being during a challenging phase of the treatment. As part of BSCHH’s holistic approach to care, the program complements its mission by supporting patients financially, psychologically as well as emotionally.

# Hospice

Bait-ul-Sukoon provides Hospice care to terminally ill patients of late 4th stage cancer requiring pain management. It is a special kind of care that focuses on the quality of life for people and their caregivers who are experiencing an advanced, life-limiting illness.

We provide Palliative care and symptom control to these patients, compassionate care for the people in the last phases of incurable disease, so that they may live as fully and comfortably as possible. Hospice care treats the symptoms of the disease and not the disease itself and affirms life with comfort in the final stage but does not try to hasten or postpone death.

A team of professionals work together to manage symptoms so that a person's last days may be spent with dignity, surrounded by their loved ones. Hospice care is also family-centered – it includes the patient and the family in making decisions.

**BSCHH has almost 100% occupancy rate for the 12 beds allocated for hospice care. Monthly cost per bed per month of the hospice care is Rs 190,830 and the annual cost is around Rs 27.50m.**
